Use the below code to add underline to a label

```
NSMutableAttributedString *attributeString = [[NSMutableAttributedString alloc] initWithString:@"This is an underlined text"];
```

```
[attributeString addAttribute:NSUnderlineStyleAttributeName
```

```
value:[NSNumber numberWithInt:1]
```

```
range:(NSRange){0,[attributeString length]};
```

Now assign the attribute to the label

```
yourLabel.attributedText = [attributeString copy];
```
