Apply a filter to filter

It is not mandatory to apply only one filter at a time. You are free to add a second or third or even more. You just experiment with multiple filters and see how it works on your images. The filter gallery panel (Filter -> Filter Gallery) gallery has a stack of filters where you can preview that how these filters interact with one another, See the image below that will demonstrate to you that by applying the Reticulation filter, the Craquelure filter works.

Let's look at some custom textures created by multiple filters.

Here this image illustrates the steps required to recreate this texture. Well, this texture begins with a blank canvas (left). You just add the Noise filter (Filter -> Noise -> Add Noise) at (middle) that introduces randomness to the scene. Also, it sets up a better foundation for the next filter. The reason is these filters work by manipulating the pixels on a layer, so in which you are going to apply, it is more important. So, when you use the Emboss filter (Filter -> Stylize -> Emboss) on its top, a newly custom texture will be created (right).

Texturing With Layer Styles

Texturing with a layer style is another way to introduce texture into your images. What it does?. Well, it offers you several extra options to adorn the contents of a layer. Here we are providing some beautiful tricks that can enhance your texturing effects. See them.

- Blending Modes
