Change the Home Screen Of Google Nest Hub

As our topic today is to check how we can change the home screen of Google nest hub, we will check them here.

Google Nest hub offers different customization options for the home screen. For example, when idle, the device will show real-time details on the home screen that we can customize. The customization includes a Clock, Photo Frame, Weather details, etc.

To do the home screen customization on Google nest hub, follow the below steps.

Step 1: Open the Google Home app on your iPhone or Android. Make sure the Google Nest Hub is connected to your Google Home app.

Step 2: You can find the Google Nest Hub device from the Google Home app screen. Once identified, click on the Device name.

Step 3: Now you can see the Nest Hub dashboard, then click on the settings icon to see the Nest Hub settings options.

Step 4: Now tap on the Photo Frame option under the Device features section.

Step 5: You can see multiple options under the Photo Frame customization section. You can select the option as per your preference.

1. Google Photos - If you select this option, your Nest Hub screen will show photos from your Google Photos. You can customize google photos by setting the library to Recent highlights, Family & Friends, Spotlight on a day, etc.
2. Art gallery - If the Art gallery is selected, some automatic images will be displayed on the screen.
3. Full screen clock - If full screen clock is selected, a real-time clock will be displayed along with some details like weather, etc. You can choose different clocks as per your preference.
4. Experimental - This option will show an animated weather fog to show the weather details.

This way, you can customize the nest hub screen with the information to make it more attractive. The google photos option makes your Nest hub a realistic photo frame that will show your memories right in front of you.

Can we set custom weather?

Currently, we dnt have the option to set a custom weather screen on the Google Nest Hub. Instead, the clock theme will show the weather within the screen, which is the only option to see the weather on the screen.

Customize Clock Screen on Google Nest Hub

Unfortunately, clock customization on Google Nest Hub is not possible now. The only option is to select from the list of the available clock from the settings section.
