

How to Create iPhone Ringtones

To do this, you can take several paths, all very simple; you have absolutely nothing to worry about.

Part 1. How to create custom iPhone ringtones via iTunes

It is not very difficult to create iPhone ringtones, and it is something that you can certainly do on your own. Below we show how to use iTunes to create custom iPhone ringtones in .m4r format.

Step 1: Launch iTunes on your computer. In the left sidebar, choose a playlist containing the desired song to turn into a ringtone.

Step 2: In the playlist, select the song you want to use for the Ringtone. Listen to music and choose 30 seconds of length or less for the Ringtone.

Step 3: Right-click on the song. In the drop-down menu, choose "Information." This brings up a small window. Click on the "Options" tab, and set the start and end time of the song. Finally, click on, OK.

Step 4: Go back to right-click, and this time from the drop-down menu, click "Create AAC Version." The created Ringtone will appear in the playlist. Drag and drop it to your computer

Step 5: The created Ringtone will be in .m4a format. You need to change the extension from .m4a to .m4r: right-click on the Ringtone and select Rename and then change the extension. If you are unable to change the extension, then, from your computer, go to Control Panel> Appearance and Options> Folder> View> uncheck "Hide extensions for known file types." Then go back to the created Ringtone, and this time you will be able to change the extension from m4a to m4r.

Suppose you want a program that allows you more straightforwardly and intuitively to cut mp3 files (or even video files) to create the desired ringtones from them. In that case, we also recommend that you take a look at Audio Mix, a small but powerful tool that allows you to cut, merge, and customize audio files for ringtone creation and more.

Part 2. How to create ringtones with the Ringtone Maker app

If you don't like iTunes or want to find some free app to create ringtones for your own, you can use Ringtone Maker. This app is very famous and ideal for creating ringtones for your iPhone (starting from any piece of music you own).

Here is the step-by-step guide: Step 1: Download the Ringtone Maker app from the iTunes Store, and install it on the iPhone.

Step 2: Open the Ringtone Maker app on your device.

Step 3: Select a song from your playlist, sound recorder, iTunes File Sharing, or Dropbox.

Step 4: Open the chosen song, and from the app, screen set the start and end time of the song for your Ringtone.

Step 5: The app will create Ringtone while the song is playing.

Step 6: At the end of the playback, click the icon next to the playback icon.

Step 7: The Ringtone will now be ready and saved in M4R format. Export the Ringtone to your computer via email or Dropbox.

Step 8: Log into your email or Dropbox on your computer to download the created Ringtone.

Part 3. How to Transfer Ringtones to iPhone

Once the Ringtone is saved on your computer, you will surely need to know how to transfer it to your iPhone or share it with friends. If the Ringtone is made in iTunes, you can sync it directly with your iPhone. If, on the other hand, you have created your Ringtone with the Ringtone Maker app, then you will need a third-party tool.

We recommend using TunesGO (for PC or Mac), which is similar to iTunes but with many more features. With it, you can quickly transfer ringtones to iPhone 11 / X / 8/7/6/5 without deleting the other songs on the device. Here's how it works:

Step 1: Connect the iPhone to the computer Use Apple's USB cable to connect your iPhone to a computer. After clicking, the iPhone will be displayed in the main program window.

Download iTunes for PC or Mac from the following links:

Step 2: Transfer ringtones to iPhone Go to the MUSIC section and then click on Add at the top to open the explorer window. Please navigate to the folder where the Ringtone is saved and click Open to upload it to your iPhone.

Besides transferring ringtones to iPhone, this software also allows you to transfer ringtones from iPhone to iTunes or from iPhone to computer in a few simple clicks!

To set a custom ringtone on the iPhone, all you have to do is grab your Apple smartphone, unlock it to access the home screen, press the Settings icon (the gear wheel), access the menu Sounds and Haptic Feedback> Ringtone, and select the ringtone name from the list that is shown to you.

If, on the other hand, you want to set the custom ringtone previously created only for a given contact in the address book, access the Contacts app (the one with the symbol from the telephone book) on the home screen, locate the reference contact, press on it, step on the word Change in the top right, then on Ringtone and choose your Ringtone from the list that is shown to you. Then tap on Finish twice in a row to confirm and apply the changes.

Note: The ringtones you create or, in any case, those that are not "standard" are separated from the latter in the list of call waiting for tones on the iPhone by a grey line and are shown to you first.
