Twitter is home to all kinds of content. It is easy to save a picture or text on Twitter but downloading a video is challenging. If you're using a device or a tablet, here are a few easy steps to download Twitter videos to watch them anywhere and whenever you want.

There are many reasons you might want to save Twitter videos, but how you do that depends on which computer you are using. If you are using a desktop or laptop, you need to use a dedicated Twitter video download page. On the other hand, if you are using a smartphone, you would find that using an app to stream Twitter videos is more comfortable.

There are so many options available to download videos from Twitter including the Twitter Video Downloader tool or via a third-party website, extension, etc. Here we are looking into different options available.

How to import Twitter videos from Chrome, Safari, or another Web browser

In this step, we are using the direct website tool rather than any Twitter video downloader extension so that you can download any Twitter video without the help of any browser extensions.

Step 1: Open your window and continue to Twitter.

Step 2: Select a video that you want to stream.

Step 3: Right-click the date alongside the account button.

Step 4: From the menu, click on copy link address.

Step 5: Go to [DownloadTwitterVideo.com](https://www.downloadtwittervideo.com) and paste the address of the tweet into the box.

Step 6: For a low-quality version of the file, click MP4, or for a high-resolution version, press MP4 HD.

Step 7: In the box below, right-click on the green button.

Step 8: Use your browser's dialogue box to rename the video and press save to finally the video saved.

How to download videos to an iPhone or iPad from Twitter

Follow the below steps in which you can easily Save Twitter Videos to iPhone or iPad.

Step 1: On your iPhone or iPad, download the free app, Documents by Redaddle, from the Apple App Store.

Step 2: Open the Twitter app and, with the tweet you want to save, find the link.

Step 3: Press the tweet, so the whole monitor is filled in. On the bottom right of your phone, click on the share button.

Step 4: Pick 'Share via tweet.'

Step 5: Press 'Copy link.'

Step 6: Leave Twitter and take Readdle to Papers. To open the browser, press the compass icon on the lower right.

Step 7: In the browser's search bar, visit the website twdown.net. To paste the video's Twitter link, double-tap the 'Enter Video link' field and select paste when the link is in the field. Press Download.

Step 8: Scroll down and pick the resolution of your chosen download (1280 x 720, 480 x 270, or 640 x 360).

Step 9: Rename the video file and press done. Then it will download the video on your iPhone or iPad.

How to download Twitter videos to an Android tablet or phone

Step 1: Install the Twitter Video app on your tablet or phone.

Step 2: Press the Sharing icon and open the video you want to download in your Twitter app.

Step 3: Press Download, Twitter.

Step 4: Click the download button and pick the version you want the video to store on your phone.

Use SaveTweetVid Video

SaveTweetVid is an online video downloader that can save photos, GIFs, and audio files from Twitter that you can locate. To download a video used in a tweet, identify the URL of the tweet in question.

You could have viewed videos without clicking on the original tweet in your Twitter account, and you can view them either by clicking the text of the tweet or by clicking the timestamp. It appears before the tweet, next to the username of the person who had uploaded the video, showing how long before the tweet was released.

For the open tweet, highlight the URL in the web browser's address bar and either right-click and pick 'Copy' or simultaneously press Ctrl+C.

It is achieved by going to the SaveTweetVid website and pasting the URL in the 'Join Twitter URL' box. Then, you can either right-click and choose 'Archive' in this area or left-click and simultaneously press Ctrl+V.

Then you can see a list of potential transfers to film. You can access twitter images at a varying resolutions like 720p, 480p, and 320p. Click the 'Download' button next to the version you're interested in and start playing it.

Click the three-dot button in the bottom right corner of the video display and click the 'Upload' option in the menu. Next, choose a video name and place to file and click 'File.' You will find that the SaveTweetVid page lists the different copies of a video that you can download.

It has a QR code that your smartphone can scan. It helps you import the latest video to your phone quickly and conveniently by merely checking the QR code, so if you want to download videos from Twitter to your phone daily, there is a neater alternative to this.

Sharing videos on Twitter

There are four methods to share the videos on Twitter:

Record: You can edit, record, and share the video using the Twitter app (Twitter for Android OS 4.1 or iPhone and above).

Import: You can download videos from your smartphone if you use the Twitter app on your iPhone or iPad.

Upload: Upload video to twitter.com.

Go live: Learn directly from your Twitter app how to create a live video.

Recording a video with a Tweet

Tap the camera icon from the top menu, or swipe left from the timeline to post a video at the moment instantly.

For capturing a video, tap and hold the capture button.

Tap Tweet once you are ready to post, or tap Add to the thread to link to your last tweet and then select Add to share.

To add your thoughts, you can tap the Tweet icon to capture or post a screenshot.

You'll see fast selection choices below the Tweet compose box to add a new video. For quick access, the most recent videos from the gallery will serve as thumbnail previews.

Click the button on the camera to take a video.

Click on the tweet to post it.
