In some countries, such as India, CapCut is officially banned. Users in these regions may face persistent network errors due to government-imposed restrictions that block the app's access to servers.

### 3. CapCut Server-Side Issues

Occasionally, the problem lies with CapCut's servers rather than the user's device. Server maintenance, high traffic loads, or technical failures can lead to temporary connectivity issues.

### 4. Outdated App Version

Using an older version of CapCut may cause incompatibility issues with its servers, resulting in network errors. Keeping the app updated ensures that you are using the most stable version with bug fixes.

### 5. Corrupted Cache and Data Overload

Over time, CapCut stores cache data on your device, which can accumulate and interfere with the app's performance. Large or corrupted cache files can prevent CapCut from establishing a proper connection to its servers.

### 6. VPN Conflicts

While VPNs can help bypass regional restrictions, they can also lead to connection issues if the chosen server is slow or incompatible with CapCut's servers.

## Solutions for Mobile Devices (Android & iOS)

### 1. Check and Optimize Your Internet Connection

- Switch between Wi-Fi and mobile data to see if the issue persists.
- Restart your Wi-Fi router or reconnect to a different network.
- If using mobile data, ensure you have a strong signal and sufficient data balance.

### 2. Clear Cache and App Data

- Android:
  - Go to Settings > Apps > CapCut > Storage
  - Tap Clear Cache (avoid Clear Data unless necessary, as it deletes projects)
- iOS:
  - Uninstall and reinstall CapCut to remove all cached data.

### 3. Update or Reinstall CapCut

- Visit the Google Play Store or Apple App Store to check for updates.
- If updating doesn't work, try uninstalling and reinstalling the app.

### 4. Enable Unrestricted Data Usage (Android Only)

- Go to Settings > Apps > CapCut > Data Usage
- Enable Unrestricted Data Usage to prevent the app from being restricted in background mode.

### 5. Use a VPN to Bypass Regional Restrictions

- Download a trusted VPN app such as ProtonVPN or ExpressVPN .
- Connect to a server in a country where CapCut is available, such as the USA, UK, or Singapore .
- Restart CapCut and check if the issue is resolved.

### 6. Adjust Private DNS Settings

- Go to Settings > Network & Internet > Private DNS
- Select Private DNS Provider and enter dns.google (Google DNS) or 1dot1dot1dot1.cloudflare-dns.com (Cloudflare DNS).

## 7. Enable Business Creator Mode

- Open CapCut and navigate to Settings .
- Enable Business Creator Mode (if available).
- Restart the app and check if the issue is resolved.

## Solutions for PC Users

### 1. Configure a VPN on Windows

- Open Windows VPN settings and add a new VPN connection.
- Select VPN Provider as "Windows (built-in)".
- Enter a server address from a country where CapCut is accessible.
- Save and connect before launching CapCut .

### 2. Change DNS Server Settings

- Open Network & Internet Settings .
- Click on Change adapter options .
- Right-click your active internet connection and select Properties .
- Select Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4) > Properties .
- Use the following DNS addresses:
  - Preferred DNS Server: 8.8.8.8 (Google DNS)
  - Alternate DNS Server: 8.8.4.4

### 3. Revert to an Older Version of CapCut

- If the latest update caused issues, uninstall CapCut.
- Download and install a previous stable version from a trusted source.

### 4. Use a Mobile Hotspot Instead of Wi-Fi

- Some users have reported success by switching to a mobile hotspot instead of home Wi-Fi.

As CapCut expands its features, ByteDance is expected to improve server stability and resolve network issues. However, users facing persistent issues might consider alternatives like:
