

How to Fix ESO Error 307: Booted From Server in Elder Scrolls Online

Quick answer

ESO Error 307 disconnects you from the server mid-game and usually stems from conflicting add-ons, an unstable IP address, or trying to reconnect too quickly after a drop.

If you're an active player of The Elder Scrolls Online (ESO), you might have come across a frustrating error message-"Error 307: Booted from Server"-which disconnects you from the game unexpectedly. This issue can be annoying, especially when you're in the middle of a quest or battle. But don't worry-this is a common error and can be fixed using a few simple steps.

What is ESO Error 307?

ESO Error 307 typically shows up when you're disconnected from the server mid-game and try to reconnect immediately. The game kicks you out and shows the message "Booted from Server." This can happen for a variety of reasons:

- Temporary server issues from ESO's side
- Instability caused by third-party add-ons
- Unstable or dynamically assigned IP addresses on your console or PC

Let's now explore how to resolve it.

Solution 1: Disable Add-ons (Especially on PC)

Add-ons or third-party mods can sometimes conflict with the game's normal functioning. Disabling them temporarily can help identify if one of them is causing the issue.

? Steps to Disable ESO Add-ons on PC:

1. Open File Explorer by pressing 'Win + E' .
2. Navigate to This PC > Documents .
3. Open the Elder Scrolls Online folder.
 - If you're using the North American server , open the 'live' folder.
 - For the European server , open the 'liveeu' folder.
4. Locate and open the AddOns folder.
5. Press 'Ctrl + A' to select all files, then cut and paste them to a backup folder elsewhere on your PC.
6. Relaunch the game and try logging in again.

? Tip: If you don't want to remove all add-ons, you can move them back one by one and check which one is causing the error.

Solution 2: Assign a Static IP to Your Console

Dynamic IP addresses can sometimes lead to unstable connections. Assigning a static IP address to your console ensures a more consistent connection to the ESO servers.

? For PlayStation Users:

1. On the PS4 home screen, press the Up button on the D-pad to access the Function menu .
2. Go to Settings > Network > View Connection Status .
3. Write down the following:
 - IP Address
 - MAC Address
4. Exit the menu.

? For Xbox Users:

1. Go to Settings > Network > Advanced Settings .
2. Write down the:
 - IP Address
 - Wired or Wireless MAC address , depending on your connection type.

Now, Set Up a Static IP Using Your Router:

1. Open a web browser on your PC or phone.
2. Enter your router's IP address (commonly '192.168.1.1' or '192.168.0.1') in the address bar and press Enter.
3. Log in using your router's admin username and password .
4. Look for a section like LAN Settings , DHCP Settings , or Manual IP Assignment .
5. Find the field to enter the MAC address and the IP address you noted earlier.
6. Save the changes and restart your router if needed.

Once the static IP is set, relaunch ESO on your console and check if the issue is resolved.

Solution 3: Wait Before Reconnecting

Sometimes, the simplest fix is just giving the game a little time.

After being disconnected, especially during a network fluctuation, ESO servers might still think you're online. If you try to log in too soon, you'll get Error 307.

? Recommendation: Wait for 10 to 15 minutes before trying to reconnect. This gives the ESO server time to clear your previous session.

Additional Tips to Prevent ESO Error 307

Here are a few bonus tips to avoid this issue in the future:

- Keep your game updated : Always install the latest patches and updates released by the ESO team.
- Use a wired connection instead of Wi-Fi for better stability, especially on consoles.
- Check ESO Server Status : Sometimes the servers themselves may be down for maintenance or experiencing issues.
- Limit background internet usage : Avoid heavy downloads or streaming on the same network while playing ESO.

Conclusion

The "ESO Error 307 - Booted from Server" might be frustrating, but it's usually temporary and can be resolved by either disabling problematic add-ons, assigning a static IP to your console, or simply waiting a bit before reconnecting.
