- Firewall & Antivirus Restrictions: Security programs may mistakenly block Marvel Rivals' connection attempts.
- Background Applications: VPNs, peer-to-peer clients, or bandwidth-heavy software running in the background can interfere with the game's performance.

### 4. Corrupt or Outdated Game Files

- Corrupt Installations: Missing or damaged game files can cause launching failures.
- Outdated Game Client: Running an older version of the game may lead to compatibility issues. Players experiencing this issue can try the following fixes to regain access to Marvel Rivals.

#### 1. Check Marvel Rivals Server Status

Before making any changes to your system, confirm whether the problem lies with the game servers. You can check:

#### 3. Disable Server Blockers or VPNs

If you use software that alters server connections (such as VPNs, server selectors, or geo-blockers), try disabling them. Some programs interfere with authentication and may cause connection failures.

#### 4. Flush Your DNS Cache

Resetting your network settings may resolve persistent connectivity issues:

1. Open the Command Prompt (type 'cmd' in the Windows search bar).
2. Enter the following commands:
  - 'ipconfig /flushdns'
  - 'netsh winsock reset'
3. Restart your computer and try launching the game again.

#### 5. Verify Game Files on Steam

Corrupted or missing files can cause launching issues. To verify and repair files:

1. Open Steam and navigate to Library .
2. Right-click Marvel Rivals and select Properties .
3. Go to Installed Files > Verify Integrity of Game Files .

4. Wait for the process to complete and relaunch the game.

## 6. Adjust Firewall and Antivirus Settings

5. Enter the following DNS values:
  - Preferred DNS: 8.8.8.8
  - Alternate DNS: 8.8.4.4
6. Save the settings and restart your internet connection.

## 8. Use a VPN (If Needed)

If you suspect regional restrictions are causing the issue, try connecting via a VPN to a different location. This can help bypass server-related connection blocks.

## 9. Reinstall the Game

If none of the above solutions work, consider uninstalling and reinstalling the game:

- Open Steam , right-click Marvel Rivals , and select Uninstall .
- Restart your PC and download the game again from Steam .

## Comparison with Similar Errors in Other Games
