However, users can enjoy FreeTube as a privacy-focused alternative which YouTube is not. This platform secures and saves subscriptions, history, and downloaded videos, stores them locally on the user's device, and never shares them with anyone else.

Installing FreeTube on Ubuntu is a simple process. Here's a step-by-step guide that will allow you to Install FreeTube on Ubuntu within no time:

Step 1: Firstly, ensure that all your Ubuntu system packages are up to date. To ensure the same, run the following command in the terminal:

```
'sudo apt update && sudo apt upgrade'
```

For launching the terminal, press Ctrl+Alt+T on your keyboard altogether.

Step 2: Once you run the command, it will update your system to its latest version. In addition, it will also refresh the APT package manager cache. Doing so is necessary so your system can recognize the latest installed packages.

Step 3: Next, download and install FreeTube. Even though this online streaming platform is an open-source application, unfortunately, it isn't available on the system repository of Ubuntu. Therefore, to download FreeTube, visit <https://freetubeapp.io/#download> and begin the downloading process depending on your operating system.

Step 4: once the DEB package file downloading is finished, you can start the installation process. And to do so, run the following command in the terminal:

```
'sudo apt install ./freetube_*_amd64.deb'
```

Step 5: That's it; you have now successfully downloaded and installed FreeTube on Ubuntu.

Step 6: Further, navigate to Activities and choose Show Applications -> FreeTube. Or, go to the Application launcher, type "FreeTube" search for it, and launch. Alternatively, you can also run the following command on the terminal: "freetube"

## How To Remove/ Uninstall FreeTube From Ubuntu?

If, at any point in time, you are not satisfied with using FreeTube on Ubuntu, you can straightaway uninstall it. Here's how you can uninstall

FreeTube from Ubuntu: Step 1: Simply open the terminal and run the following command:

```
'sudo apt remove freetube'
```

That's it. You are done now.

## Install FreeTube Player on Ubuntu as a Flatpak package

Users can also install FreeTube on Ubuntu as a Flatpak package. However, it is important to have this technology enabled in their device to do the same.

Step 1: Once the Flatpak packages are installed on your system, run the following command in the terminal: flatpak install flathub io.freetubeapp.FreeTube

Step 2: Now wait for the installation process to complete, and when it is done, run the following command in the terminal to launch the application:

```
'flatpak run io.freetubeapp.FreeTube'
```

Step 3: You can now start using FreeTube on Ubuntu.

## How To Remove/ Uninstall FreeTube From Ubuntu using Flatpak?

If you want to remove or uninstall FreeTube from Ubuntu using Flatpak, here is all that you need to do:

Step 1: Launch the terminal and run the following command:

```
'flatpak uninstall io.freetubeapp.FreeTube'
```

That's it. You are done.

## How To Use FreeTube?

To use FreeTube, here's all that you need to do:

1. Firstly, launch the FreeTube application on your desktop. To do so, go to the app menu, search for FreeTube, and click on it to launch.
2. Now, on FreeTube, visit the Search/Go to URL box, click here, start typing whatever you want to watch, and press Enter.
3. Now, locate the relevant option from the search results, click on it, and it will start playing. You can pause, play, forward, and backward the video as you do on YouTube.
4. Users can also track their YouTube subscriptions in FreeTube without signing up to YouTube separately. Simply go to Search /Go to URL box, type the YouTube channel's name you need to subscribe to, and press Enter.

## Is FreeTube Free To Use?

Yes, FreeTube is an open-source application and completely free to use. This app allows users to browse YouTube more privately than browsing directly on the platform. FreeTube does not utilize the official YouTube API. Instead, it uses a method like Youtube-dl to parse the required data from the YouTube platform.

However, despite being a free-to-use open platform, FreeTube is privacy-focused. It blocks trackers, disables ads, and implements privacy features for a more secure and private environment.
