How to Install Stremio on Ubuntu?

1. Firstly, open your web browser and head over to the Stremio Download page.

2. Now, look for the Debian/Ubuntu version and click on it.
3. Now, to install Stremio Debian packages, open the command terminal by pressing CTRL+ALT+T.
4. Further switch to your Downloads directory, where your browser downloads files. `cd Downloads`
5. Now install the open-source Stremio streaming application for Ubuntu 20.04/18.04 using this command:
`sudo apt install ./stremio*amd64.deb`
6. Here if you encounter a dependency error, try running one of these commands: `sudo apt install -f` or `sudo apt -fix-broken install`
7. Further, if you still face dependency issues like "libfdk-aac1 (>=0.1.5) but it is not installable," you can resolve it with these two commands: `wget http://mirrors.kernel.org/ubuntu/pool/multiverse/f/fdk-aac/libfdk-aac1_0.1.6-1_amd64.deb` `sudo apt install ./libfdk-aac1_*_amd64.deb`
8. Now, rerun the installation command: `sudo apt install ./stremio*amd64.deb`

How to Use Stremio on Ubuntu?

1. Firstly, search for the Stremio media streaming application in your Ubuntu 20.04 applications.
2. Now Sign up either with your Email ID or Facebook profile.
3. Once logged in, click on the three icons on the top right and select "Add-ons."
4. Now choose the category you want to add related add-ons for.
5. Further, scroll and click on the green "Install" buttons for the add-ons you want to use or install all if you're unsure.
6. Now return to the Stremio app's home screen and search for the movie or series you want to watch.
7. Several sources will appear for the media file you want. Test them one by one, as some may be slower than others. Once playback starts, you can enjoy your content. Or you can also use an external player and open subtitles within Stremio for an enhanced viewing experience.

For Uninstalling Stremio on Ubuntu

In case using Stremio on Ubuntu isn't your choice anymore, or you found a better streaming platform, uninstallation is an option. Here's how you can uninstall Stremio on Ubuntu:

1. Open the command terminal by pressing CTRL+ALT+T and copy + paste the following command, `$sudo apt autoremove -purge Stremio`
2. Allow time for the uninstallation process.

Is Stremio Paid or Free?

Stremio is an open source, totally free tool. There are no in-app purchases, and it can be downloaded and installed for free on Windows, MacOS, Linux, iPhones and iPads (iOS), Android phones and tablets, and Android TV. You can download add-ons and stream stuff for free. Stremio runs unobtrusive ads to fund its operations.
