But the fact is that most of those available apps that worked previously are not working these days. So, it is suitable for those who wish to keep their Instagram account hidden from the public so that no apps can access Instagram Private accounts.

We also recommended all the users to follow the legit way to see the profile of any Instagram user. It is the best and risk-free way to see any Instagram account's profile posts, photos, and videos.

How to Set an Instagram Account in Private Mode

Here, we will tell how you can set the privacy to a private state so that your Instagram profile will no longer be available to public users. Only your followers can see your posts, including photos and videos.

It is good to keep all the personal photos and videos hidden if you don't want to show them to those not on your followers list.

Instagram Private Mode - Only your approved followers can see your photos and videos in your posts.

Instagram Public Mode - Anyone on the internet, whether having an Instagram account or not, can view your profile details, images, and videos if they get your profile Id/URL.

Set Instagram Account Private on IOS and Android

Step 1: From the Instagram app, go to your profile and click on the profile picture.

Step 2: Click on the menu at the top right (3 horizontal bars).

Step 3: From the menu, click on the Settings option (Gear-like icon).

Step 4: You can find the Privacy option on the settings page. Click on that.

Step 5: Now, select the 'Private Account' option, and your profile is now changed to a private account.

Set Instagram Account to Private Mode from PC/Laptop Browser

Step 1: Log in to the Instagram account and click on the profile at the top right corner.

Step 2: From the dropdown, click on the Profile option to reach the profile page.

Step 3: Now click on the 'Edit Profile' button.

Step 4: From the next page, click on the 'Privacy and Security' option.

Step 5: Select the 'Private Account' option from the Account Privacy page, and your account will not be public anymore.

Set Instagram Account to Private Mode from Mobile Browser

Step 1: Log in to the Instagram account and click on the profile picture at the bottom right corner.

Step 2: From the profile page, click on the Settings icon (Gear Like Icon) at the top left of the screen.

Step 3: Form the next page, click on the 'Privacy and Security' option.

Step 4: You can see 'Private Account' as the first option. Select that option, and your profile will be converted to a private Instagram account.

Does Anyone Can see My Instagram Profile After Making Private?

Your Instagram Account will be publicly available, private, or public. However, if the account is private, none of your Instagram posts will be available to the general user. Anyone accessing your account can see only your name, photo, and other details. They won't be able to see any single post.

Who Can see my Instagram Posts after making the account Private?

Only your friends can view your posts and activities once you have made your Instagram Profile Posts into a Private Account. For the public users, it won't be available. The only way to view a private account post is to be on the friend's list.

Can I See Popular Instagram Account For Free

As said above, any Instagram account can be viewed and publicly available. Similarly, popular and most searched Instagram account profiles can also be assessed using their username. However, if the posts are private, they won't be available to anyone outside the friend list.
