1. Download, install, and launch TuneFab on your computer

Directly go to TuneFab's official website and download the Amazon Music Converter to your computer. TuneFab can run smoothly on both Windows and Mac systems as a handy audio converter tool. - Operating System: Windows 7 or later on 64 bit system, Mac OS X 10.12 or higher
- Processor: Any processor that is above 1 GHz
- RAM: 512 MB or higher of RAM
- Minimum disk space: 1 GB of free disk space for storage of converted music content
- Internet Access: Broadband connectivity

After a successful installation, launch the program, then a prompt window will appear with a quick demonstration of using the software.

2. Log in to your Amazon Music account

This special music converter is integrated with the Amazon Music web player. And it requires you to log in with an eligible Amazon account to access the Amazon Music library.

3. Stream, find your favorite songs, playlists, or podcasts, then add them to the queue

Click on the Convert All button, and then all the selected music tracks will be converted to your chosen music format efficiently. To check your music conversion history, go directly to the "Finished" tab to view all music content.

Tip: After the conversion process, you can put the converted Amazon Prime music on a USB flash disk or hard drive for backup or transfer the converted MP3 audio to an old MP3 player to enjoy offline.
