Step 5: In the Popup 3 options will be available, always use SIM 1, Always use SIM 2 and Ask every time,

Set your preference accordingly; if you choose the 3rd option, each time you send a message or make a call, it will ask you which SIM card to use. Do the same steps for Call settings also so that the dual sim phones can have the default selection.
