Charging Your Beats Solo 3 Wireless Headphones

 - Five white lights : Fully charged
 - One red light : Low battery

Tip: A quick 5-minute charge (Fast Fuel) provides up to 3 hours of playback.

How to Put Beats Solo 3 in Pairing Mode

To connect your headphones to any device, you need to put them in pairing mode:

1. Turn on the headphones : Press and hold the power button on the right ear cup until the LED light turns on.
2. Enter pairing mode : Hold the power button for 5 seconds until the LED begins flashing. This indicates the headphones are discoverable.
3. If the light is solid white, the headphones are already connected to another device. Hold the power button for 5 seconds to reset pairing mode.

Pairing Beats Solo 3 with Different Devices

1. Pairing with an iPhone, iPad, or iPod Touch

Beats Solo 3 pairs effortlessly with Apple devices, especially those running iOS 10 or later.

1. Turn on your headphones and place them in pairing mode.
2. Unlock your Apple device and ensure Bluetooth is enabled.
3. Bring the headphones close to your device. A setup prompt will appear on the screen.
4. Tap Connect and follow the on-screen instructions.

2. Pairing with a Mac or MacBook

1. Place the headphones in pairing mode.
2. On your Mac, go to the Apple menu > System Settings > Bluetooth .
3. Enable Bluetooth and locate your Beats Solo 3 under the Nearby Devices list.
4. Select the headphones and click Connect .

3. Pairing with an Android Phone or Tablet

1. Put the headphones in pairing mode.
2. Open the Settings app on your Android device.
3. Navigate to Connections > Bluetooth and toggle it on.
4. Let the device scan for nearby devices. Select Beats Solo 3 from the available devices list to pair.

4. Pairing with a Windows PC

1. Enable pairing mode on the headphones.
2. On your Windows PC, go to Start > Settings > Devices > Bluetooth & other devices .
3. Toggle Bluetooth on and click Add Bluetooth or other device .
4. Select Bluetooth in the pop-up menu and wait for your Beats Solo 3 to appear.
5. Click on the device name to complete the pairing.

Using Beats Solo 3 Wireless Headphones

Controls

- Power Button : Press and hold to turn the headphones on or off.
- Volume Control : Use the "b" button on the left ear cup to adjust the volume:
 - Press the top for volume up.
 - Press the bottom for volume down.
- Playback Control : Use the "b" button for:
 - Play/Pause: Single press
 - Skip Track: Double press
 - Previous Track: Triple press
- Call Management : Single press the "b" button to answer or end calls.

Troubleshooting Common Issues

1. Resetting Your Headphones

If your headphones are unresponsive or not pairing:

1. Hold the power button and volume down button simultaneously for 10 seconds.
2. Release them when the LED light flashes.

2. Resolving Connection Issues

- Ensure the headphones are charged.
- Keep the device and headphones within 10 feet for a stable connection.
- Avoid wireless interference from microwaves, routers, or other Bluetooth devices.

3. Updating Firmware

Connect your headphones to the Beats Updater (available on the official Beats by Dre website) to ensure they are running the latest firmware.

Bonus Tips

- Range : For best performance, maintain a distance of less than 30 feet between the headphones and the connected device.
- Multi-Device Pairing : To switch devices, disconnect from the current one before pairing with another.
