If your device doesn't belong to the set Netflix household, you might see this error: Your device isn't part of the Netflix Household for this account.

Sharing Netflix Outside Your Home: The "Extra Member" Option

Netflix has introduced a legitimate way to share your account with people outside your household by paying a small extra monthly fee.

Extra Member Feature Breakdown:

- Standard Plan -> Add 1 extra member
- Premium Plan -> Add up to 2 extra members
- Not available for ad-supported or third-party-billed plans

How It Works:

- Extra members get their own login, password, and viewing history.

Setting Up and Managing Your Netflix Household

Setting a "primary location" ensures Netflix knows which network is your home base.

Steps to Set Primary Location (on a Smart TV):

1. Go to Home Screen and ensure the TV is on your home Wi-Fi.
2. Navigate to Get Help > Manage Netflix Household .
3. Choose verification method (email or SMS).
4. Click the verification link received.
5. Check for confirmation on TV screen and email.

TIP: Reconnect all household devices to your Wi-Fi at least once every 30 days to retain trusted status.

Moving Out? Use Profile Transfer Feature

If someone is moving out and wants their own account, you can help them transfer their profile.

Profile Transfer Steps:

1. Enable profile transfer from Settings > Account .
2. Open the confirmation email and activate it.
3. Select the profile to transfer.
4. Enter new account email and password.
5. Choose a subscription plan.

Personal viewing history, recommendations, My List, and saved games are retained.

Quote: Kids profiles cannot be transferred.

Using Netflix While Traveling

If you're away from your home network, you can still use Netflix temporarily by verifying your device.

Temporary Access Process:

1. Select " Watch Temporarily " when prompted.
2. Choose email or text for verification.
3. Enter the code received.
4. Start streaming.

Regional Considerations:

- Available content may vary by country.
- Downloaded titles may be restricted.
- Ratings and suggestions change based on location.

Monitor and Manage Devices on Your Account

To keep your account secure and manage active devices:

How to Check:

1. Go to Netflix.com > Account > Manage Access and Devices .
2. View list of logged-in devices, their locations, and activity timestamps.
3. Click Sign Out next to any suspicious or unused device.
