## Start with their own backyard-does their website convert?

Pop their URL into Ahrefs or SEMrush: look for consistent organic traffic growth, not just a one-off spike. While you're there, check page speed and mobile usability. Also scan their blog. Generic 500-word posts stuffed with "best SEO company Sydney" are relics of 2015. You want fresh, data-driven articles that answer real questions-think schema markup guides, case studies on BERT updates, or local-link tactics after the helpful-content shake-ups.

## Demand transparency before you sign

Send a short list of questions: What KPIs do they report monthly? Do they share raw GSC data? How will they build links in 2025-HARO, digital PR, or niche edits? Fast, detailed replies indicate process maturity. Agencies that deflect with "it's proprietary" are usually buying cheap PBN links on your behalf.

## Verify past wins, not glossy logos

Ethical agencies set 90-day sprint goals (technical fixes, content gap closure, baseline authority links) and tie bonuses to organic revenue, not position #1 for a vanity keyword. Insist on a 30-day opt-out if KPIs stall after two consecutive quarters. That clause alone filters 70 % of the cowboys.
