Steps to Stop Wifi to turn on Automatically on Android

Step 1: The first step is to Unlock your smartphone and go into the settings section

Step2: After selecting the setting option, you need to tap the Network and Internet settings and then go to WiFi. On some devices, it is mentioned as Connections rather than Network.

Step 3: Now you need to tap on the menu option on the top right corner. You can see 3 dots at the top corner. Click on that.

Step 4: Now you will get additional options. From that click on Advanced.

Step 5: On the Advanced page, you will get additional WiFi preferences. You can notice an option by which WiFi automatically On/Off option. Just turn that off.

Turning off that feature will stop your Wifi from automatically turning on when a WiFi network is detected.

You can also turn off the Connect to open network toggle while you are on that page easily. However, it would be better for you to understand that connecting to the open network is unsafe for your privacy and may also face some issues. Therefore, make sure you are turning it off so that you would never connect to unknown open networks.

At last, if your Wi-Fi is still turning on by itself, then there are still a few things you can try from your side. If the issue is related to viruses or any glitch, then chances are you would be able to get back the normal functionality of your WiFi after the factory reset.

You should note that a factory reset will delete all of your personal data that is not on your SD card, so it is highly recommended to create a backup before proceeding further for sure. The factory reset is the last option you need to consider if you face the same issues.

How to Stop Wifi from Turning Off Automatically Android

On the other side, some users are experiencing the issue just opposite to what we explained above. Here the issue is that Wifi gets turned off automatically. So, if you are looking to stop wifi from turning off automatically android, check the following points.

1. Mainly, on most devices, if the Wifi connection, automatic reconnection is enabled by default. The settings ensure that if your device moves away from the Wifi range and later comes back to the network range, this option helps your device automatically reconnect to the network. But in case the setting is disabled, the automatic reconnection won't work, and your device won't connect to the network.
2. On some devices, there is an auto-sleep option in which if you are not connected to any Wifi network, the device will automatically turn off the Wifi. So make sure this option is not enabled on your device.
3. Some third-party applications can customize and automatically turn off the Wifi on your device. In this case, you can check for any such application on your Android device. If found any app, check for the setting or uninstall the application.
4. Some system bugs also can cause this issue in some cases. In this case, you can check for any available system update from your device manufacturer. If it was a known issue, the device OEM might have released some bug-fixing update for you. If available, download and install the patch.

Finally, you are aware of the best steps you need to follow for stopping WiFi from turning on automatically on android devices. All the above-mentioned steps will help you in turning off your WiFi so that it will never turn on automatically for sure. Also, you need to understand that this feature is currently available in the recent Android version, and you may not get it in previous versions.
