- Right-click or tap and select Mark as Spoiler .
- Discord will automatically apply the spoiler format.

### 3. For Images or Attachments

- Before sending, check the box that says Mark as Spoiler in the upload menu.
- Your image will be hidden until someone chooses to view it.

## Tips for Spoiler Etiquette

- Use spoiler tags for anything fresh : big plot twists, new movie releases, or game endings.
- Give context if needed, so people know what they're clicking into. For example: "||Ending of Episode 5||."
- Don't overuse them : not everything needs to be hidden, so keep it for actual surprises or sensitive details.
