

How to View and Manage Liked and Saved Posts on Instagram

? How to View Posts You've Liked on Instagram

Steps to View Your Liked Posts:

1. Open the Instagram app on your device.
2. Tap your profile icon at the bottom right corner.
3. Tap the menu (three lines) at the top right.
4. Select Your activity .
5. Tap on Likes under the "Interactions" section.

You will now see a list/grid of all posts you've liked. Instagram allows you to sort and filter these posts based on:

- Date range
- Content type (Posts, Reels, or Threads)
- Author

This makes it easier to locate specific content you've engaged with previously.

? How to Unlike Posts in Bulk

Sometimes, your liked posts may influence what appears on your feed or in the ads you see. If you want to remove these influences, you can easily unlike posts:

1. Follow the same steps above to reach your Liked section.
2. Tap Select in the top-right corner.
3. Choose the posts you want to unlike.
4. Tap Unlike , and confirm the action.

This bulk unlike feature helps clean up your interaction history quickly.

? Save Instagram Posts Without Liking Them

While likes are a quick way to engage with content, they aren't ideal for long-term storage. If you want to revisit a post without signaling to Instagram's algorithm, use the Save feature.

Benefits of Saving Posts:

- Saved posts are private.
- You can organize them into collections .
- They are easier to access compared to liked posts.

? How to Save Posts to Collections

1. Tap the bookmark icon beneath the post.
2. Choose an existing collection or create a new one .
3. Name your collection (e.g., "Inspiration", "DIY Ideas", "Fitness Tips").
4. Optionally, turn on collaborative collections to let friends contribute.
5. Tap Save .

These collections work like categorized folders, helping you organize content efficiently.

? How to View Saved Posts on Instagram

To access your saved posts and collections:

1. Go to your profile .
2. Tap the menu icon .
3. Select Saved .

Here you'll find:

- All Posts you've saved.
- Custom collections you've created.
