The budget handset receives popularity due to its build quality and the near Stock Android Look. Initially, every Max Pro M1 user thought they would get timely updates like Android 10 and Android 11 for the Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1, but Asus failed to provide the latest update.

As we all know, Now it is 2022, and Google will release the Android 13, but Max Pro users are unlucky to receive even an Android 10 update. So one option available for the Max Pro M1 users is to migrate to a custom ROM. Alternatively, install the beta version of Android 10, which is still available. In this article, we will explain how you can install the beta version of Android 10 on your Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1.

Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1 Update to Android 10

The hope for the Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1 users is not to fade out completely. The popular Stock Android smartphone from Asus received the official beta version of the latest Android 10 update. But unfortunately, the update was not even stable after two years of internal testing. So, till now, the Asus Max Pro M1 users have been waiting for the stable Android 10 update.

After waiting for more than a year after the initial beta release, we think that it is 2022, and Asus won't roll out the official update; hence, we don't have to wait anymore and think about an alternative option to update Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1 to Android 10 or even Android 11.

However, if you want your Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1 to run on the beta version of the Android 10 operating system, you can update it manually without any tricks. The main highlight of the latest Android 10 update is the gesture-based navigation and the in-build dark mode.

Asus Znfone Max Pro M1 Android 10 Update Procedure

Here we will look at how you can install the latest Android 10 Beta Update on your Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1.

- Step 1 : Download the full OTA update package from the official Asus website. You can download the update by clicking the link below. You can download the zip file either on your mobile or desktop.
- Step 2 : Once the file is downloaded, copy the file to the root of your SD card or the Internal memory. Better to copy the file to the SD card.

- Step 3 : After copying the file, you need to restart your device. Once the mobile got booted back, the system will automatically detect the update, and you will get a notification saying the update was detected.
- Step 4 : Click on the notification and update the device. It will take a few minutes to complete the update, and after reboot, your Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1 will get updated to the latest Android 10.

Download Full OTA Update for your Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1

Note: The details mentioned here are about the beta version of Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1, released in December 2020. Asus was still lagging in rolling out the stable version of Android 10.

Important things to remember before doing the update

It is noted that the latest update is still in the beta version, and hence you may find some bugs or issues; however, being a public beta version, it is worth using.

But the most important thing here is before you start updating the device, please make sure you have removed the device lock settings like PIN, Password, Pattern, etc.

The update sometimes causes a device lock which in which you will not be able to unlock the device after the update. For example, here is the case that we experienced after the update.

The device was updated to Android 10. However, after reboot, the device asked for the security pattern we used before. But, in our case, after the Android 10 update, the pattern was removed automatically due to the update. So the device could not identify the pattern we used, and we got locked. So the only option left was to hard reset the device from the recovery menu. Then we freshly configured the system. And we lost all the data on the phone.

So, we highly recommend removing all the security keys, including PIN, Password, Pattern, etc., from your phone before the update. Then, once the phone is booted back on the new OS, you can add your pattern, PIN, password, etc.

Is the Beta Xersion of Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1 is Stable?

As the name says, the beta version may contain bugs. Even the stable version of Asus Max Pro M1 includes bugs, and the beta version is not updated to a stable version even after two years. So we can say it is not a bug-free update. However, to experience the Android 10 Update on Asus Max Pro M1, you can try it.

Official Android 10 Update For Zenfone Max Pro M1

All the companies are releasing Android devices with the latest Android 11 or the upcoming Android 12, so we don't think Asus will still work on Max Pro M1. So, the official Android 10 update for Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1 won't happen anymore.

What is the best way to get the Latest Android Update on Max Pro M1

The best option available is to install any stable custom ROM. We tried multiple custom ROMs on Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1 and found them even more stable than the official Android. Several custom ROMs are available, and you can find the best suite as per your choice. The good thing about the Custom ROM for Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1 is that you can even get stable Android 11 on your Asus Max Pro M1.

However, always go for a trusted sources like the XDA forum for any unofficial updates and tweaks. You will get enough support and help there if you move forward to install custom ROM on Max Pro M1.

Does Warranty Void while Installing Custom ROM on Max Pro M1?

Yes, the warranty of Max Pro M1 will lose if you install any custom ROM on the device. However, most devices have already passed the warranty period, so the warranty concerns are not relevant here.

Did Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1 Failed in Getting Update?

Asus Zenfone Max Pro M1 is a good budget handset available at the time of release. It was introduced with good hardware and with a premium build quality. What made the phone more attractive was near the Android stock experience. Due to these reasons, the phone became so popular and gained users quickly.

But sadly, Asus failed to provide a timely software update to the handset. The Android 10 update was an assured update to the handset. But the company was unable to deliver it on time. The beta version was released multiple times, and due to the bug, it was withdrawn. So regarding the software update, the phone was not a success.
