That's it! Your iPhone display will appear in a resizable window on your PC.

Method 3: Use AirDroid Cast

If you're looking for flexibility, AirDroid Cast is one of the best cross-platform screen mirroring apps available. It supports casting over USB, Wi-Fi, or even remotely using a 9-digit code.

The free version includes local mode, which gives you lag-free screen sharing over the same Wi-Fi network.

How to Use AirDroid Cast:

Method 4: ApowerMirror (Freemium with Decent Free Features)

ApowerMirror is a well-known mirroring tool for both Android and iOS. While the free version includes some limitations, like watermarks and time limits, it's still a viable option if you're testing or only need occasional screen sharing.

How to Mirror:

1. Install ApowerMirror on your PC and iPhone.
2. Connect both devices to the same Wi-Fi.
3. Open the app and tap Screen Mirroring on your iPhone.
4. Select ApowerMirror_[device] and start broadcasting.

If you want to mirror via USB instead (more stable), connect your iPhone using a Lightning cable and follow the on-screen prompts.

Good for: Testing, short sessions, or occasional demos.

Note: The watermark on the free version may be intrusive for professional presentations.
