You'll likely lead the frontend developers, which is why your salary will be between \$60,000-\$120,000.

SEO Specialist

Rather than focusing on the functioning of the online casino, the role of the SEO specialist is to put the casino on the map. As you may already know, SEO stands for 'Search Engine Optimization', and describes the tricks and tactics used to boost a website's ranking on search engines such as Google. The role involves formatting the online casino and using the right links and keywords to ensure that it appears high on search rankings, allowing players to find it easily. You can expect to earn anything between \$25,000-\$60,000 a year.
