During the 56 days validity time, users can also enjoy Vodafone Play service too.

But the downside of this plan is there is no data benefit with this. Since users are paying this high amount for this plan and not getting any data benefits is now a days not so good. All the networks are now offering unlimited calls, data with the same rates.

Does it worth recharging the Rs. 351 Plan

If you are only using the mobile for calls and not for data, then you can consider the plan. But on the same side if you can spend 50 to 100 rs more, then you will get other plan with 70 to 84 days validity with call, sms and data.
