Add the code below `define('WP_DEBUG', false);` line.

```
@ini_set('log_errors','Off'); // enable or disable php error logging (use 'On' or 'Off')
```

```
@ini_set('display_errors','Off'); // enable or disable public display of errors (use 'On' or 'Off')
```

Done, no more error logging now.
