Changing Bio Font

Adding extra flair to an Instagram bio can make a page stand out more. For example, if you want to use a custom font for the bio text, go to your Instagram profile, tap Edit Profile, and paste the text you created with a text generator and a custom font. Save the changes, and your profile's bio will now look different.

Changing Stories Font

Unlike the bio, Instagram Stories have some different fonts themselves. When creating a story, click on the Aa button, and you will get access to some available fonts.

The built-in number of fonts in Instagram stories is hardly enough. Considering that these fonts are available for everyone, you are better off using a third-party text generator with custom fonts, particularly if you want your Stories text to stand out from what Instagram users usually see on the platform.

3 Rules to Follow When Using Custom Fonts on Instagram

1. Accessibility

As a rule of thumb, you must be careful about which fonts you use. Even though custom fonts are based on Unicode characters based on a universal code, there might be some instances when characters do not appear on specific devices or operating systems.

Be careful, and if you are uncertain whether a font is compatible with devices, people use to browse Instagram, test the font beforehand or avoid them in the first place.

2. Consistency

Finding a font that is consistent with your brand can be tricky. However, given the plethora of available custom fonts, you might want to try as many variations as possible. After all, testing new fonts can be fun.

However, it is about retaining consistency. After determining one or two fonts that go well with your brand, stick to those.

3. Restraint

There is no need to add different custom fonts to all your Instagram posts. Overusing fonts will make your content repetitive, which is one of the problems you want to solve first, right?
