## Clear Browser Data

2. Remove YouTube-Specific Site Data:
  - Settings -> Privacy -> Cookies and site data -> See all site data -> Search "YouTube"
  - Remove all shown results.

## Check Extensions

1. Disable all browser extensions.
  2. Reload the YouTube page.
  3. Re-enable them one by one to spot the troublemaker.
- Some ad blockers or script blockers are known to interfere with YouTube's functionality.

## Fixes for Mobile App Users

1. Update the YouTube App
  - Open App Store (iOS) or Play Store (Android) and install any pending updates.
2. Clear App Cache (Android)
  - Go to: 'Settings -> Apps -> YouTube -> Storage -> Clear Cache'
3. Reinstall the App
  - Uninstall YouTube and reinstall it from the app store.
4. Disable Restricted Mode
  - Open YouTube App -> Tap Profile -> Settings -> General -> Turn off Restricted Mode.

## Check Network & Connection

1. Test Internet Speed
  - Use sites like Fast.com or Speedtest.net
2. Switch Network
  - Try switching between Wi-Fi and mobile data.
3. Restart Your Modem/Router
  - Power off for 3 minutes and restart.
4. Turn Off VPN or Proxy

- Some VPNs can block or misroute YouTube data, causing partial loading.

## For YouTube Creators

If you're a creator and your comments are missing:

### 1. Check Video Settings

- Go to YouTube Studio -> Select video -> Edit -> Show More -> Comments and ratings
- Ensure "Allow all comments" is enabled.

### 2. Review Channel Defaults

- Studio -> Settings -> Community -> Defaults -> Ensure comments are not held for review or turned off.

### 3. Verify Content Type

- Videos marked "for kids" (under COPPA rules) won't have comments.

### 4. Moderation Settings

- Too-strict filters may block all or most comments.
- Adjust filters under: Settings -> Community -> Automated filters

## Additional Tips & Best Practices

- Keep Software Updated: Regularly update browsers, apps, and OS for best compatibility.
- Minimize Browser Add-ons: Only keep essential extensions to avoid script interference.
- Clear Cache Monthly: Prevents buildup of corrupt or outdated data.
- Use Reliable Internet: Consider a wired connection or high-speed Wi-Fi for smoother loading.
